Minimum Gear Requirements

We will be transported in by snowcat on a 5 mile long road. **Please arrive wearing ski gear and ready to load the cat. There aren't bathrooms at the loading site so please plan accordingly in your travels.**

Gear List

Ski/Snowboard Gear:

- o Skis/Snowboard
- o Poles
- o Ski/Snowboard Boots
- o While we provide avalanche equipment we encourage you to use your own

Suggested Clothing:

- o Light Weight or mid weight LS polypro shirt
- o Fleece jacket or Puffy Coat
- o Hard Shell Jacket.
- o 1 pair warm gloves
- o 1 pair spare gloves or Shell Gloves/mitts
- o Warm Hat
- o 1 pair Good wool or synthetic ski socks, check the fit of your socks in boots before the trip
- o 1 pair light weight long underwear
- o Shell Pants

Backpack:

- o Pack capable of carrying skis/snowboard helpful if it has a separate shovel/probe pocket. We provide a Backpack, beacon, probe, shovel kit if you don't have one.
